PHYSICAL THERAPIST/ SERVICE COORDINATOR

Immediate opening, full or part time, to join a transdisciplinary team in a nationally recognized early intervention program to provide direct services to infants and toddlers with disabilities or developmental delays and their families. Bachelor's degree and licensure required. Experience working with children, birth to three, in home and center-based settings; delivering family-centered services; and providing service coordination is highly desirable.

Must be a highly motivated individual with excellent oral and written communication and interpersonal skills. Must have knowledge and understanding of a) infant and toddler development, disabling conditions and their impact; b) federal and state regulations related to early intervention; and c) family-centered service delivery using a team approach.

Current infant and child CPR certification, criminal history, CPS and sexual offenders registry check required. TB test must be in accordance with state regulations. Must be able to communicate orally in person, by telephone, and in writing with families and staff. Must possess the skills and ability to use equipment necessary to carry out job responsibilities (e.g. computer, telephone, and facsimile machine). Must be able to travel independently by car, attend meetings off-site, and perform home visits. Salary based on experience and credentials. Excellent benefits.
