Triage requests for Part C services and prioritizes needs; completes initial home visits; completes comprehensive assessments via developmental screenings, interviews, review of medical records, and collaborative contacts. Coordinates child find activities for Part C program and maintains strong relationships with referral sources. The candidate needs to have a minimum of three (3) years experience in developmental screenings and assessments with infants and toddlers with developmental disabilities and a master's degree in Early Childhood Education (ECSE), Occupational Therapy (OT), Physical Therapy (PT), Speech Therapy (SLP) , Social Work or a related field is required.
