

## **Provider Database – Availability, Credentialing, and Training**

### **Purposes:**

DMAS	Verify that providers submitting to provide services under the Early Intervention program are certified and credentialed with the appropriate training. Also verify credentialing for a provider submitting data for delivered services. Provide information to MCOs.
State	Manage credentialing and certification data. Send email communications to providers.
Local Systems	Know who the providers are and what other providers are available in the area.
Families	Access information to select providers in their area and by their specialty.

### **Information that needs to be included as database elements:**

1. Lists of required training modules
2. Available certifications for specific provider types.
3. List of providers with their contact information, malpractice insurance information, background check results, licenses, specialties, degrees, locations served, language(s), special interests, and availability.

### **To be tracked for each provider:**

1. Training modules each provider has taken and when.
2. Certifications the provider is required to complete and their progress in completing it.
